II. Team Dues

There is great deal of expense involved with running the swim team. Therefore, a fee is required.

The dues per swimmer are \$185 for the year. The dues will help cover the pool fees, meet entries, short-sleeve team t-shirt, snacks for meets and breakfast meetings, kick-off event, end of season banquet, website hosting, end-of- season gifts and awards, etc.

Checks should be made payable to: Wheeler High School Swim and Dive Booster.

III. Team Information

Practices

Team Practices take place at the Cobb Aquatic Center (CAC) in Marietta at the following times:

Because practices are off-site, it is the responsibility of each athlete to secure their own transportation.

Uniform

The uniform for the day of swim & dive competition is as follows:

- Team Shirt (provided by the Booster Club)
- Team Suit (legal fast suits may be worn during championship meets, i.e. County and State)
- Team Cap or State Team Cap (State cap may only be worn if you have qualified for state in the CURRENT season)
- Do NOT wear any jewelry!

Attendance

Practices

- a. All swimmers and divers are expected to attend all practices.
- b. However, the coaches are aware that there might be other commitments that arise. Therefore, each athlete is allowed **five** personal days on which they are allowed to miss practice without penalty; but athletes **must** contact one of the coaches **before** the missed practice.
- c. Athletes may miss because of illness or medical appointments without penalty; a note is required.
- d. Athletes who are practicing with a USS team or year round dive team may continue to practice with that team. However, swimmers must attend a minimum of four practices a week and divers two. You must complete the attendance form, available on the blog, monthly.
- e. Athletes who miss practice for school sponsored events must notify the coaches **prior** to missing practice. The coaches will determine whether the absences are excused or unexcused.
- f. Excessive unexcused absences will result in disciplinary action including, but not limited to, suspension from one or more meets, suspension from the team and expulsion from the team.

Holiday Practices

- a. The swim team will be practicing during the winter break. Athletes are expected to make every effort to attend. You must contact a coach if you will not be able to attend these practices.
- b. Practices will be held at the CAC for swimmers and divers. The days and times will be determined later.

Meets

- a. If an athlete is absent from school on the day of a meet or on Friday if it is a Saturday meet, (s)he may not swim in the meet.
- b. If there is an unexpected conflict, and an athlete is not able to attend a meet, (s)he must notify the coaches in writing (or by email) the Monday before the meet.
- c. Not every athlete will be entered into every meet, but we will do our best to give every athlete as many opportunities to compete as possible.
- d. If a swimmer desires to swim a specific event, we will entertain those requests received in writing from the athlete. However, the coaches reserve the right to create the line-up as they see fit and might not be able to accommodate every request.

- e. Nonattendance at a meet without written notice and approval will result in disciplinary action including but not limited to suspension from one or more meets, from the team and expulsion from the team.
- f. Nonattendance at a meet, with or without notification, may jeopardize a swimmer's eligibility to letter.
- g. All meets at the Cobb Aquatic Center and Mt. View Aquatic Center are considered home meets and swimmers will be responsible for their own transportation.

Expectations and Standards of Athletes

- Every member of the Wheeler High School Swim and Dive Team has a duty to represent himself/herself, the team, and the school in the best manner possible. Because of the high visibility of all athletes in the school, when accepting a position on the team, every member must agree to abide by a higher standard of character, values and behavior than an average student. This applies to your behavior both in school AND out, before, during and after the season. You are expected to avoid situations where you might be accused of wrong-doing. Additionally, you are expected to follow the rules outlined in the student hand book and by those defined by the county in the "J" rule. Failure to comport yourself in the manner becoming a Wheeler Swim and Dive athlete will result in team and school disciplinary action.
- If you quit the team, for whatever reason, the coaching staff reserves the right to prohibit you from trying out, joining and/or competing with the Wheeler Swim and Dive team in succeeding seasons.
- Should you be disciplined in school and receive one of the following punishments: administrative detention, in school suspension and/or out of school suspension; then you may also face disciplinary action from the team, including but not limited to one or more meet suspension, or removal from the team.

Requirements for Lettering

All team members will be eligible for a Varsity Letter if the following criteria are met and are subject to the coaches' discretion; the coaches' decision is final:

- 1. Adhere to the code of contact of the Wheeler Swim and Dive Team, Wheeler High School and the Cobb County School District.
- 2. Attendance:
 - a. Attend 90% of practices excluding the five personal days
 - b. Attend all the meets that (s)he is entered by the coaches.
 - c. Attend all team meetings
- 3. Performance:
 - a. Qualify for the County Championship or the State Meet (relays count)
 - b. Show a marked improvement or determination to improve as seen by the coaches

Swim & Dive Meets

Most meets will occur on the weekends, and depending on the meet, may last anywhere from 3 hours to 8 hours. All meet information will be posted on the team's blog and calendar. Any meet at held at the Cobb Aquatic Center or the Mountain View Aquatic Center are considered "home" meets and each athlete will need to provide his/her own transportation.
